ICWL OPEN TOURNAMENT (CLUB SPONSORED)

Sunday, March 2nd, 2008 at Conestoga High School, Berwyn PA.

Bensalem will be hosting satellite weigh-ins for this event on Friday, February 29th from 6:00-8:00 PM at Bensalem High School. If you are interested, please submit your completed registration form along with \$9.00 (50% of the registration fee) to Stacey Kisselback during practice by Wednesday, February 20th, 2008. Please note the ICWL rules for eligibility for this tournament.

1. The wrestler must be on the teams ICWL roster by the League's February meeting (2/4/08)
2. The wrestler had to only represent his/her ICWL team, school, or independent in tournaments hosted by an ICWL member club held between 12/1/07 and Sunday, March 2nd, 2008.
3. The wrestler had to have been available to participate in at least 50% of his/her teams ICWL dual meets. If the wrestler is on a school team which forbids it's wrestlers from competing in ICWL meets, he/she is exempt from this rule.
4. The wrestler must reside within a geographic service area of an ICWL member team.

GETTING INVOLVED

On **Monday, March 10, at 7:00 PM**, we will be holding a meeting at Neshaminy High School to discuss and obtain committee members for the 2008-2009 wrestling season. Since this was our first year in the Inter-County Wrestling League, we have realized that some of our committee positions are no longer needed, however, a few new ones had to be added. If you would like to become involved and have a voice in the club, please attend the meeting and help fill one of the following positions:

Registration Coordinator - Oversee the registration process, help distribute flyers to schools and place signs throughout the communities, attend and have volunteers attend the sign up dates and locations.

Attendance Coordinator - Responsible for keeping the ICWL match sign up sheets and taking attendance the day of the scheduled meet.

Fundraising Coordinator - In charge of obtaining and having others obtain sponsorships for the club, and any other fundraising event that may take place.

Purchasing Coordinator - Responsible for yearly t-shirts, sweat suits, end of the year trophies, and any other NYWC merchandise that may need to be purchased.

Publications Coordinator (Pinner)- Responsible for formatting, printing and distributing of the bi-weekly or weekly newsletters.

Public Relations Coordinator (Web Site) - Responsible for posting information on the NYWC website.

League Representative - Should be available to attend all ICWL meetings and relay the information to the board members, committee, and members of NYWC.

Alternate League Representative - Available to attend all ICWL meetings and relay the information to the members of NYWC.

Equipment Manager - In charge of handing out singlets, taking singlet deposits, and singlet return.

Gym Set-up Coordinator - Responsible for setting up and obtaining volunteers to help set up mats at all home meets.

First Aid - Responsible for the first aid kits, preferably someone who is CPR certified, but not a must.

Snack Stand Coordinator - In charge of buying, setting up, and coordinating all snack stand duties for home matches.

Tournament Coordinator - Investigate outside tournaments, provide tournament registration forms to the club members, and coordinate satellite weigh-ins if applicable.

Cheerleading Coach - Provide instruction, support, and direction for the cheerleaders during practices, home meets and any outside competitions if applicable.

Wrestling Coach - Provide instruction, support, and direction for the wrestlers during practices and NYWC competitions.

Match Coordinator - Responsible for contacting coaches of opposing clubs for weekly match ups, utilize the match man system, and enter data after matches. This person should be computer savvy (he/she will be taught how to use applicable programs), and be familiar with the wrestlers skill levels.

Home Meet Coordinator - This person will be responsible for overseeing all aspects of hosting a home meet. They will be in contact with the school regarding match times, responsible for obtaining referees, and be in contact with the gym set up coordinator and snack stand coordinator to make sure all areas are covered.

A successful club is only successful with the help from volunteers. What a great way to show your child/children that you support them. Mark your calendars, come on out and help fill the many needed volunteer positions so that we can make the 2008-2009 wrestling season a HUGE success.
